### Proper use

The drives in the STA 1 range are designed exclusively for opening and closing weight-counterbalanced sectional doors.

## **Target group**

Only qualified and trained specialists are permitted to install and service the drive. Qualified and trained professionals fulfil the following requirements:

- Have knowledge of the general and specific safety and accident prevention regulations,
- Have knowledge of the relevant regulations,
- Be trained in the use and care of appropriate safety equipment,
- Be capable of recognising the dangers associated with the installation work.

Only qualified and trained specialists are permitted to install and service the drive. Qualified and trained professionals fulfil the following requirements:

- Have knowledge of the general and specific safety and accident prevention regulations,
- Have knowledge of the relevant electrical regulations.
- Be trained in the use and care of appropriate safety equipment.

# Instructions for installation and connection





## 4. Overview of sectional door drive:






- A. Drive unit

# 5. Install connector piece




Insert the connector piece (A) into carriage (B) and securely clamp it in place with two M8x30 cylinder head screws and two M8 lock nuts.

# 6. Install guide rail


# 6.1 Install lintel joining plate

Fix the lintel joining plate (A) to the lintel or to the ceiling using 3 wood screws Ø8x60, wall plugs and washers. Distance from top edge of spring shaft (B) to wall plug holes 35 mm.



# 6.2 Fix drive to guide rail

Use the set which is indicated for attaching the drive:



1x STAI1 support plate (A)

2x connector clamp for support plate (B)

4x fixing screw (C)

1x STAI1 intermediate flange (D)

1x STAI1 pin (E)


4x cylinder head screw M10x25 (F)

4x spring washers DIN127-A10 (G)

4x countersunk screw M8x35 (H)

#### 6.2.1

Insert the pin supplied (E) into the sleeve shaft of the drive. Ensure the correct seating of the feather key.









# 6.2.2

STAI1 Attach the intermediate flange (D) to the drive using countersunk screws (H).




## 6.2.4

Attach the STAI1 support plate (A) to the rail supplied with the aid of connector clamp (B) and the corresponding screws (C).


Attach the STAI1 support plate (A) to the intermediate flange using cylinder head screws (F) and spring washers (G).



# 6.3 Install guide rail

D Suspension cramps


B Support plate






#### 6.3.1

Connect the guide rail (S) to the lintel joining plate (A). Use M8x110 hexagon head screw and M8 lock nut.




# 6.3.2 (optional)

Fix support plate (B) to the ceiling with the designated drive unit suspension set (set 1 - 4). (See Figs. 6.4 - 6.7)



## 6.3.3 (optional)


Anchor the centre of the guide rail to the ceiling with two suspension cramps (D) and the rail suspension set (set 1 - 4) designated for the lintel height. (See Figs. 6.8 - 6.11)
















## 7. Connect door to drive



Disassemble the existing door latches or render them inoperable.


#### 7.1

Set the adjustable door connector attachment (D) to the uppermost door section height and screw on with four self-tapping screws A 6.5x16 (bore ø5mm). Connect the three-part door link (C) with the connector piece (F).



# 7.2

To ensure fault-free, power-operated door travel, the angle of the door link must not exceed 15° when the door is open.



## 8. Quick release


Pull cable (A) downwards and the door can be moved without the drive unit.



#### Attention:

If the sectional door is not balanced, the door link system is blocked and quick release is not possible.


Pull cable (B) downwards and, once it has engaged, the door can be moved again with the drive.



# 9. Tension the drive chain

(whenever necessary)

The chain can be tensioned by rotating the hexagon head screw (A) in a clockwise direction.
